

■ Take back of used electric devices

Dear valued customer,

According to WEEE (**W**aste of **E**lectrical and **E**lectronic **E**quipment) / ElektroG you have the possibility to return the b2b electrical and electronic equipment purchased from **BEKO TECHNOLOGIES GmbH**, which is no longer used, as waste electrical equipment free of charge.

Examples of "pure" b2b devices

- Products that are not in household-like use due to their size, volume and/or weight.
- Operating permit required, e.g. according to the Telecommunications Act or the X-ray Ordinance.
- Assembly/disassembly of the devices/waste equipment only by specialised personnel
- Consequence: Product type does not occur in municipal collection systems

Device

- Electrical and electronic equipment for the end user (E+E equipment) § 3 No. 1 ElektroG
- Voltage limits: 1,000 V AC or 1,500 V DC

Generation, transmission, measurement of electric currents, electromagnetic fields Category ("Open Scope" as of 15.08.2018)

- Prerequisite however (FAQ Directive 2002/96/EC):
- independent function ("direct function" is available to the user - without further processing)
- End product (finished product)

Component

- Intended for further processing/assembly
- part of another product
- not a terminal device
- no independent function
- **No "device" as defined by the ElektroG**

For the sake of the environment: The transport of electrical appliances also consumes resources and pollutes our environment. Please help us to keep this consumption of resources as low as possible and only make use of the WEEE take-back service if you actually need it.



■ Take back of used electric devices

What has to be considered for the return of used electrical appliances?

- If you wish to hand in WEEE (**W**aste of **E**lectrical and **E**lectronic **E**quipment) that does not fall into one of the aforementioned categories of the Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act, please use your local qualified disposal company.
- The WEEE must be dry, clean and free of contamination (e.g. condensate or oil residues) inside and out.
- In the case of refrigeration dryers, the refrigerant must be professionally removed beforehand.
- Batteries or rechargeable batteries must be removed.
- Permanently installed rechargeable batteries or batteries must not be damaged.
- If the unit contains storage media, all personal data and information must be deleted (back up beforehand if necessary). **BEKO TECHNOLOGIES GmbH** accepts no liability for any data that may be on the storage medium.
- The old electrical appliance must be packed properly, in the same way as you received it from us. We will be pleased to assist you in the choice of packaging.
- If the above-mentioned requirements are not taken into account for the returned old electrical equipment, **BEKO TECHNOLOGIES GmbH** reserves the right to return the equipment at the customer's expense or to have it professionally processed before disposal.
- Packaging and delivery note with the marking: **Used electrical device to be returned**
- The customer shall bear the transport costs for the return to **BEKO TECHNOLOGIES GmbH**.
