UFI labelling for hazardous mixtures acc. to Article 45 - CLP regulation

As of this year, all importers and subsequent users are obliged to report hazardous mixtures with physical and health hazards in the EU member states in which the products are distributed. There is an obligation to label the products accordingly and to assign a so-called 16-digit UFI number ("Unique Formula Identifier"). The UFI number is the implementation of the information from Article 45 of EU Regulation 1272/2008 according to which the exact composition of the mixture must be declared. Since this is a European regulation, you will find the UFI number on products from all EU countries in the future.

The registration for Germany has been completed. Until recently, it was unclear how other EU countries and EFTA member states would register the applicable UFI numbers. As countries only gradually register on the ECHA portal, we can also only initiate further registrations step by step.

ECHA portal = EACH (European Chemicals Agency) is responsible for the central administration of the UFI number. Currently, the registrations for Denmark, France, Ireland, Italy, the Netherlands, Switzerland, Austria, Poland and Sweden are being processed. As soon as additional countries are connected to the ECHA portal, further countries can also be registered.

- The UFI number should help to take the right measures in case of intoxication. The toxicological emergency centres have access to a list of these numbers and can thus quickly and reliably identify the ingredients and properties of the product.
- The UFI numbers are always encrypted data, so the composition of the mixture cannot be accessed externally. Suppliers can therefore pass on the code in the supply chain without hesitation.
